JOB SUMMARY:

Responsible for spiritual needs of participants and staff.

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Provide transportation to religious services in Ely every Sunday for staff.
2. Act as counseling resource for participants and staff.
3. Provide daily vesper services for off-road crews.
4. Work with base management to keep staff morale high.
5. Train crews in Duty to God program.
6. Assist in the responsibilities of the Check In Office including:
 - a. Greeting crews.
 - b. Checking in crew paperwork.
 - c. Issuing permits.
 - d. Assisting with Adult Training Follow Up.
7. Perform other duties as assigned by the Base management. These duties may include such things as trail clearing, dishwashing, maintenance projects, custodial work, helping in other departments, and other projects as needed.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Ordination preferred, lay or seminary student qualifications accepted based on other experience factors. Counseling training desirable.
2. Be a registered member of BSA, Scouts Canada, or the International Camp Staff program.
