FEATURED SCOUT PROGRAMS

Flora and Fauna in the Fur Trade

Animals and plants are everywhere, but it takes skill to learn to track a fox or to know which plants are edible. Take a walk through the pristine landscape of Fort William and learn about the medicinal uses of many plants. Then look for animal tracks, make your own cast imprint of one, and set traps, all while learning the survival tactics of animals such as rabbits, fox, and more!

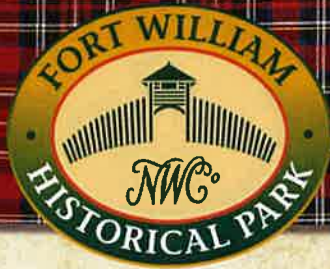


Earn Astronomy Badges at the David Thompson Astronomical Observatory.

Northern Tier Scout Adventures AT FORT WILLIAM HISTORICAL PARK

Let Fort William Historical Park set the stage for your travels on historic voyageur routes. Each step in your journey brings you closer to understanding what life was like at Fort William in 1815. Get into a period costume and spend a night in one of Canada's top living history sites. We offer multiple facilities for daytime and overnight programming year-round. The Bell House and East House feature bunk beds, kitchen, showers, washrooms and a common room. Scouts and Guides can also sleep in period-style tents in the voyageur camp outside the palisade or in our Learning Wigwam dependent on the season.

OVERNIGHT ADVENTURES

Choose a one-night package like our Design-Your-Own Overnight, which can include historic meals and costumes. Choose from our selection of badge specific programs to create an experience that fits the requirements for your group or choose leisurely activities such as musket firing, on water activities and historic games prior to your canoe trek. We also offer a full featured Fort William Overnight program (either 1 or 2 nights) which includes meals, costumes, extra programming and accommodations.

Fees

Design-Your-Own Overnight

- One night - \$24/participant, leaders complimentary (minimum 10 participants)
- Customers select 3 full programs (1.5-2 hours each)
- Bring your own food and prepare it in our facility's kitchenette

Fort William Overnight

- One night - \$60/student, \$30/chaperone (minimum 10 participants)
- Includes historic meals, costumes, and programming for the duration of your visit
